

New World Bank representative meets Faure Gnassingbe

The new World Bank resident representative in Togo, Hervé Assah, on Tuesday met President Faure Essozimna Gnassingbe with their discussions focusing the West African country's economy.

Mr Assah, who is a Congolese, met President Gnassingbe after signing a financing agreement between the World Bank and Togo to boost the country's economy and improve governance.

The US\$16.3 million grant was approved for Togo in Washington on 20 May by the Bank's board of governors.
